# Black History Month

This October, at Chilwell everyone has been learning about the origins of Black History Month and celebrating the achievements and contributions of Black people to the UK and around the world. As part of our celebrations each year group has also chosen a focus for their follow up activities in class.

Reception children have been exploring their family history, sharing and discussing their family photos. Year I have been exploring Kente Cloth and designing their own outfit using the traditional patterns. Year 2 have learnt about Marcus Rashford and his work to help children. Year 3 and 4 have been exploring Music of Black Origin, discussing styles, lyrics and meaning. They have also had the opportunity of working with Matt Windle, a talented local poet and performance artist. Year 5 have researched influential black authors, including Priscilla Mante and Mallory Blackman, and key figures from UK history. Year 6 have been exploring the work of the sculptor Willard Wigan and mixed media artist Kehinde Wiley.

During half term families are invited to take part in the Titan Art Competition and all children are invited to take part in the school art competition, to celebrate what Black History Month means to them. We hope to have more opportunities across the year to work with local people who represent Black history in the making - our living history.
