Reading: The children will be reading short texts and answering comprehension questions to support their understanding of the text.


English

In this unit, pupils retrieve digital content from the Internet for a particular purpose and use mind mapping software to organise their questions and answers about a topic. They use presentation software to present their findings to an audience.

Topic

Geography - *coastlines*. This term, children will be learning about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of Whitby, in Yorkshire
