Identify that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

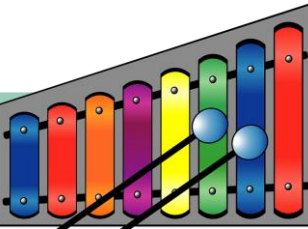
## Cornerstones
