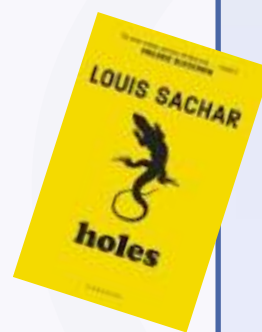

Cornerstones

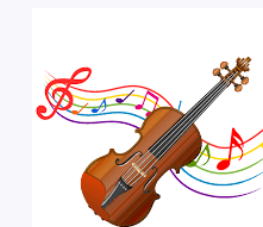
In Cornerstones this term, we will be looking at the unit: Britain at War, with a focus on WW2

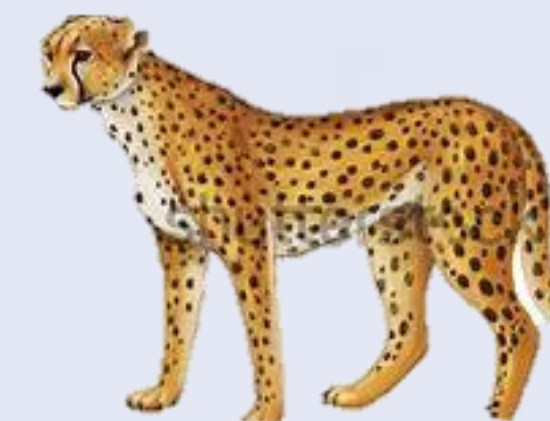

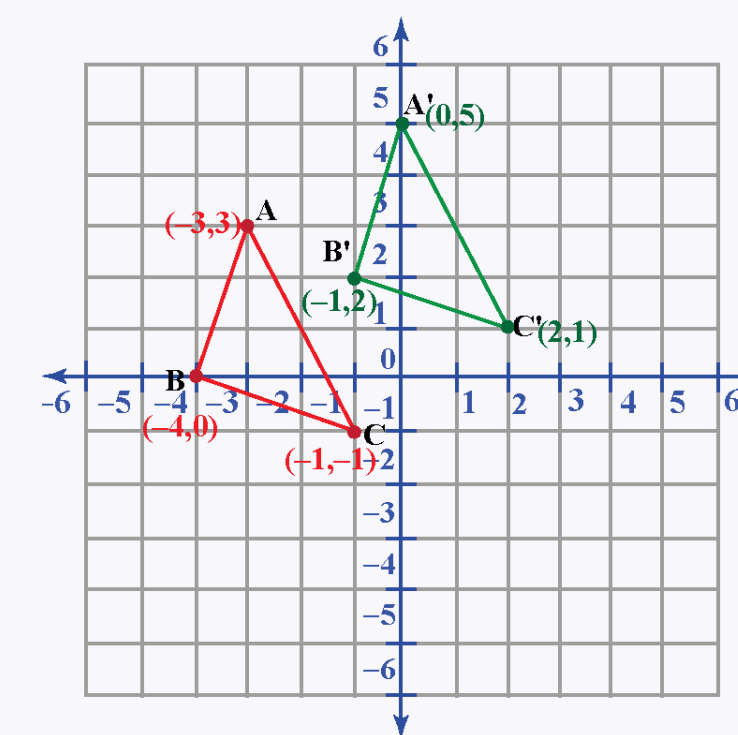


Mathematics
