They will also gain the knowledge and skills to create short phrases in Spanish and recognize, remember and spell action verbs..

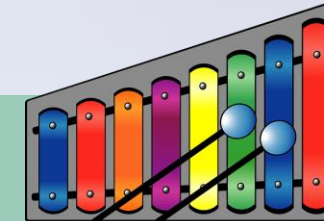
History and Geography
