## Topic

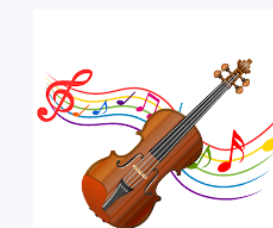
Geography: Brazil and Chili- Use maps, globes etc.. Locate countries and cities associated with South America. Learn geographical terms such as: equator, north/south hemispheres, latitude and longitude.

### History: The kingdom of Benin

Learn about The Kingdom and its place in history. Understanding what Benin was like 500-1000 years ago. Learn about Benin from historical artefacts. Learn what changed when European settlers started to trade. What were the effects of the Victorians becoming involved? Asking if artefacts should be returned.

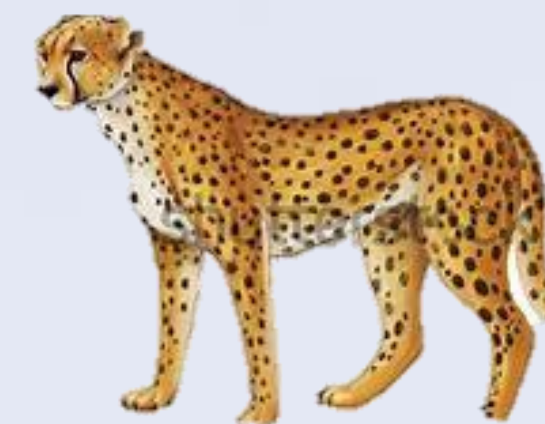
Check your internet security settings. Did you know you can set the internet to only be accessible at specific times from certain devices? We are more than happy to help with this - please contact the school office for support.

## Mathematics

### Place Value

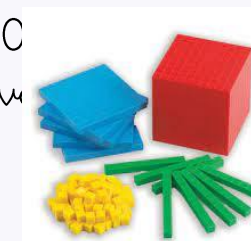
In this maths unit, year 6 will:

- read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000,000 and determine the value of each digit
- round any whole number to a required degree of accuracy
- use negative numbers in context, and calculate intervals across C
- solve number and practical problems that involve all of the above

### Addition and Subtraction

In this maths unit, year 6 will:

- multiply multi-digit numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using the formal written method of long multiplication
- divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using the formal written method of long division, and interpret remainders
- use their knowledge of the order of operations to carry out calculations involving the 4 operations
- solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems in contexts
- solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
