# English


#### **Writing**


#### Science

In Science this term we will be exploring the unit: Materials.

We will be exploring different materials, their uses, and their properties, as well as dissolving, separating mixtures and irreversible changes. The children will sort and classify objects according to their properties. They will explore the properties of materials to find the most suitable material for different purposes. The children will work scientifically and conduct collaboratively when investigating.

We will be exploring the life of King Henry VIII came to power, how the Tudor's line of monarchs, including Elzabeth shaped the course of British history. We also learn about the War of the Roses and how it came to an end.
