Geography

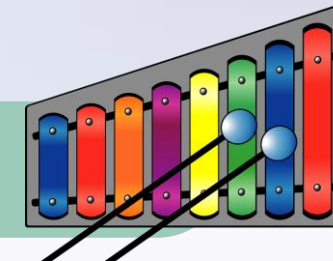
