Geography and History



Mathematics

Place Value

In this maths unit, year 6 will:

•read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000,000 and determine the value of each digit

•round any whole number to a required degree of accuracy

use negative numbers in context, and calculate intervals across 0
solve number and practical problems that involve all of the above

Addition and Subtraction

In this maths unit, year 6 will:

- •multiply multi-digit numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using the formal written method of long multiplication
- •divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using the formal written method of long division, and interpret remainders
- •use their knowledge of the order of operations to carry out calculations involving the 4 operations
- solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems in contexts
 solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division

<u>DT-</u> Gears and Pulleys- understand how gears and pulleys work, create a simple gear system and a simple pulley system using construction techniques.


How can you help at home?
