How can you help at home?

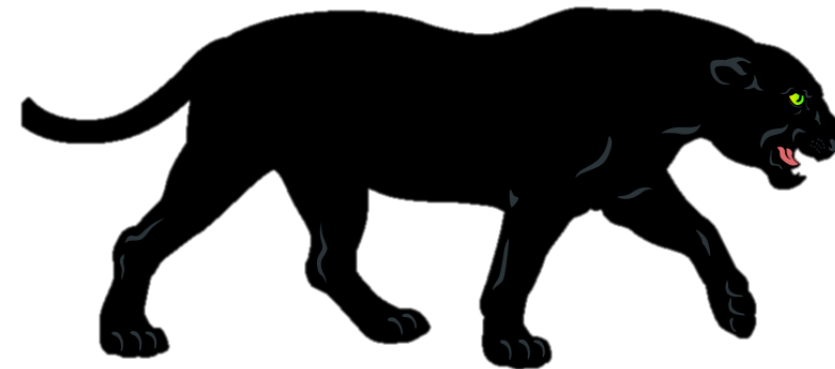
- If you have any concerns or questions please get in touch with your child's class teacher via the school office.
