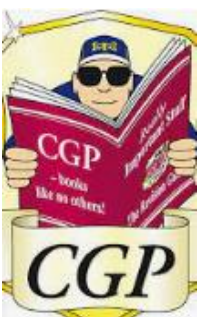
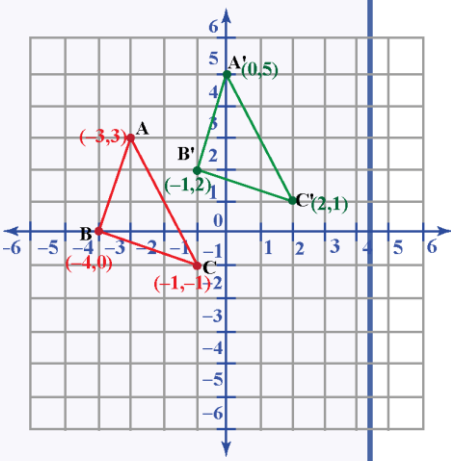


## Art and DT

## Mathematics
